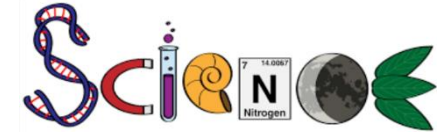

Year 2 - Spring - 2 - Animals Including Humans

Knowledge:

- I can notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- I can find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- I can describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

Vocabulary:

Offspring – children from a parent.
 Reproduction – to have offspring.
 Growth – to increase in size throughout life.
 Baby, Toddler, Child, Teenager, Adult, Old person – stages of a human life cycle.
 Survive – to remain alive.
 Life cycle – the journey of a living thing from it's beginning to the end.

I can make observations and describe how an animal grows and changes in its life cycle.
