Key Knowledge

- Helping people can include: Share things, return things that have been lent or shared with you, take turns, listen carefully when you need to help others when they are stuck with their work and help others to enjoy their break times - for example by inviting them to joining in a game if they're alone or being excluded.
- Sometimes it does feel as though words or thoughts are trying to 'erupt' from our mouths but that we do have a choice about this.
- We can take control of our actions and words.
- We can take control by asking for help, getting somebodies attention or by explaining to someone why I need help.
- When someone answers a 999 call, the caller tells them who they are and what has happened. This person will then work out what service they require.
- We all have choices about how we spend money - there will be time when we have lots to spend and other times when we save for something bigger.
- We need to make sure we spend our money on things to help us to live but also spend money on things we want to make our lives more enjoyable and comfortable.
- One of the risks of the internet is when people (children or grownups) talk to people they don't know!
- Sometimes these people may seem kind, but they might be trying to trick us.

Essential - Something you need.
