#### Knowledge:

Stella McCartney was born in London, England in 1971.

Her dad is Sir Paul McCartney from the Beatles.

She is a fashion designer.

She is a supporter of animal rights and refuses to use leather or fur in her work.

Fashion design is the art of designing clothes.

#### Skills

#### Vocabulary:

Fashion design – applying design ideas to clothes and accessories.

Pattern – a design which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated.

Fabric – cloth or material.

Observation – looking closely at something.

Compare – look at similarities and differences between two or more things.

Designers – a person who plans the look or workings of something before it is made.

Texture – the surface quality of a piece of work.

Tone – how light or dark something is.
