Vocabulary

Impressionism – an art style using thin, small brush strokes.
 Palette – made up of lots of colours to create art.
 Pointillism – an art style using small, colourful dots to create a pattern or picture, developed by Georges Seurat.
 Share – to show or tell someone about something or someone.
 Surrealism – an art style which is like lots of ideas put into one piece of art.
