

### Literacy:

Children will take part in daily phonic sessions and will be assessed at the end of Summer 2. Children will delve into sea themed stories;

'The Rainbow Fish' as well as 'Rainbow fish to the rescue' and 'Starry Eyed Stan'. During English lessons the children will build up skills to re write the story 'The Storm Whale'. Children will have lots of opportunities for story writing, Re-writes and nonfiction writing.

### Communication and Language:

Through our theme of Under the Sea, children will lead in asking about their learning and ask questions about our text 'The Storm Whale' as well as a range of nonfiction texts. They will learn new vocabulary and repetitive phrases and have plenty of opportunities to delve into role play. Children will also learn about talking in different tense through news reporting.

### Religious Education:

Children will be learning about why Jesus is special.

# Summer 2 Overview

## Theme: Under the Sea

### Personal, social, and emotional development:

Children have daily opportunity to reinforce the importance of hygiene, independence and show perseverance when faced with a challenge. Children Will participate in activities based around our key theme. Children will have activities based around commonality and respecting differences. Also learning about democracy and voting. Children will have a transition session into Y1 to start adapting to a new environment.

### Understanding the world:

Children will experience learning about different sea creatures and read nonfiction books. Seashells will be used for observational drawings. Children will also be learning about the importance of recycling and looking after our oceans.

### Blended knowledge and experiences:

Children will have the opportunity to explore The Blue Planet Aquarium on a school trip. This trip will enhance their learning and build upon knowledge they have already learnt about under the sea.

### Maths:

Children will deepen their learning on patterns. They will also build, visualise, and create maps. Children will consolidate their learning in maths.

### Physical Development:

During PE lessons children will be focusing on the lesson unit-Speed, agility and travel. As well as manipulation and co-ordination. Children will access the finger gym within continuous provision. Also, participating in activities to strengthen fine and gross motor skills and daily dough discos.

Children will also participate in sports day.

### Expressive arts and design:

Children will have weekly Sing Up lessons. They will participate in a range of role pay opportunities within our Under the Sea area. Children will build on skills and produce a shoe box underwater scene. Children will learn a dance linked to under the sea.
