Knowledge:

- I know how to score points.

- I know the role of the wicket keeper and backstop.

Skills:

- Make choices about where to hit the ball
- Make tactical decisions about where to position themselves in the field
- Has developed hitting skills with a variety of bats
- Practised bowling/feeding a ball to other players Run in a game to score points
- Attempted to play the role of wicket keeper or backstop
- Makes attempts to catch balls coming towards player in games
- Can work in small groups to field and bat
- Display sportsmanship when competing against others

Lesson Sequence:

1. I can time my run around a base to stay safe.
2. I can kick a ball into space using different parts of my foot.
3. I can respond to how a ball is being bowled when hitting.
4. I understand the role of the wicketkeeper.
5. I understand the role of a backstop and how similar it is to a wicketkeeper.
6. I can bowl underarm in a game with accuracy.
