Knowledge:

- Antoni Gaudi was born in Spain in 1852.
- He was an architect.
- An architect is a person who designs buildings.
- Most of his work is located in Barcelona.
- He was also known for creating mosaics.
- A mosaic is a piece of art often made from lots of small pieces of stone or glass.
- Name at least 1 of Gaudi's pieces of work.

Vocabulary:

Gaudi - Antoni Gaudi, an architect from Spain.

Architect - a person who designs buildings.

Mosaic - a picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of stone, tile, glass, etc.

Glass - a hard, brittle substance, typically transparent or translucent.

Stone - a hard, brittle substance, typically transparent or translucent.

Shape - A shape is a two-dimensional area.

Colour - a way that we describe an object based on the way that it reflects or emits light.

Composition - the way in which different elements of an artwork are combined or arranged.
