#### Knowledge:

- I know what Christians believe about creation, the fall and salvation.

#### Vocabulary:

Fall- move from a higher to a lower level, typically rapidly and without control.

Creation- the creating of the universe, especially when regards as an act of God.

Salvation- deliverance from sin and its consequences, believed by Christians to be brought about by faith in Christ.

Bible - Christian Holy book

Genesis - deliverance from sin and its consequences believed by Christians to be brought about by faith in Christ.

#### Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I can explain how Christians find and use ancient wisdom from the Bible and create a class holy book.

Lesson 2: I can understand the different parts of the Bible.

Lesson 3: I can describe some ways Christians say God is like, with examples from the Bible.
