arable farming	farming involving growing crops like wheat and barley in a field
pastoral farming	farming involving raising and caring for animals like sheep and cows
farmer	a person who owns or manages a farm
processed	produce that has been changed
distributed	spread out or delivered throughout an area
mixed farming	farmers who grow crops and look after animals
harvest	the gathering of a crop
yield	the amount of a crop that is produced
fertiliser	a substance that is spread on the ground to make plants grow more successfully
