Knowledge:

- To know what makes a safe password.
- To learn methods for keeping passwords safe.
- To understand how the Internet can be used in effective communication.
- To understand how a blog can be used to communicate with a wider audience.
- To consider the truth of the content of websites.
- To learn about the meaning of age restrictions symbols on digital media and devices.

Vocabulary:

Password – what we use to get into programmes, apps, phones, devices, etc.

Internet – made of computers connected to each other around the world.

Blog – Piece of writing online like a journal or diary.

Concept Map – a way of organising and presenting ideas on a subject.

Username – used to log in to apps, devices, etc along with a password.

Website – A collection of connected webpages.

Webpage – A single digital document.

Spoof Website – a fake website.

PEGI Rating – tells us which age something is suitable for.

Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I know what makes a password safe and how to use the internet effectively.

Lesson 2: I can recognise spoof websites and understand that some information might be inaccurate.

Lesson 3: I can recognise the age restriction symbols and who to turn to if I need support online.
