Knowledge

Vocabulary

Trust - firm belief in the reliability, truth, or ability of someone or something.

Incarnation – God became a man in Jesus Christ.

Salvation – rescued from sin and its consequences.

Resurrection – brought back to life.

Gospel – record and teaching of Christ's life.

Holy Week – week in the church calendar leading up to Easter.

Gethsemane - the garden outside Jerusalem mentioned in Mark 14 as the scene of the agony and arrest of Jesus. : a place or occasion of great mental or spiritual suffering.

Jerusalem - A holy city for Jews, Christians, and Muslims; the capital of the ancient kingdom of Judah and of the modern state of Israel. The name means 'city of peace.'
