He is remembered for his generosity and is the inspiration for Santa Claus.</p> <p>St Lucia</p> <p>A girl from Sweden who is remembered for helping others during a time of darkness. People celebrate her on December 13th with candles and songs, especially in Scandinavian countries.</p> <p>Orthodox</p> <p>A branch of Christianity found in places like Russia, Greece, and Eastern Europe.
