Knowledge:

- I know how art shows what people believe about God
- I can share my own views on what is important

Vocabulary:

Sacred Something very special and holy. It is often connected to God or religion and treated with great respect.

Art Creative work like paintings, drawings, or sculptures that express ideas, feelings, or beliefs.

Muslim A person who follows the religion of Islam.

Islam A religion that teaches belief in one God (Allah) and follows the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad.

Christian A person who follows the religion of Christianity.

Christianity A religion based on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ.

Architecture The design and building of structures like houses, temples, mosques, and churches.

Calligraphy Beautiful, decorative writing often used in religious texts and art.

Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 2: I can show understanding of the value of sacred buildings.

Lesson 3: I can explain how and why Muslim charities try to change the world.

Lesson 4: I can explain how and why Christian Aid tries to change the world.
