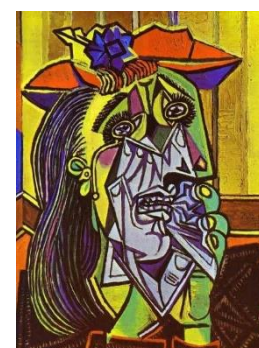
<p><u>Knowledge:</u></p> <p>Drawing is a picture made up of different types of lines.</p> <p>A portrait is a painting or drawing of a person, usually only their face or head and shoulders</p> <p>Pablo Picasso was a cubist artist. He was born in Spain in 1881 He liked to use lots of lines and colours .</p>	<p><u>Skills</u></p> <p>Can experiment with drawing different types of lines.</p> <p>Can begin to produce lines in a range of different tones using the same pencil.</p> <p>Can work from observation.</p> <p>Can begin to draw to scale.</p>	<p><u>Vocabulary:</u></p> <p>Abstract Art – It has colours, lines and shapes and it can look like an unrealistic image. 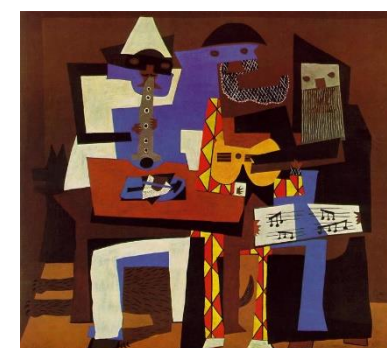
