Knowledge:

Know that that classroom rules are there for us to be safe and be able to learn.
 Know that bullying is repeated.
 Know that teasing is done with the intention to annoy somebody.
 Know that being unkind can cause upset for somebody.
 Know that people can be similar and different, and that these differences are ok and normal.
 Know that people are sometimes judged for being different but this is unkind.
 Know that my special people are different to other people's special people and my reasons may be different to other people's and this is ok.
 Know that school rules are in place to keep me safe and help me to learn.
 Know that fair and unfair relates to things that I need, not what I want to have.

Vocabulary

Similarities: The quality or state of being similar.
 Differences: The quality or state of being different.
 Positive: Relating to good things.
 Unkind: Behaving in a way that is not nice.
 Tease: To make fun of or try to annoy someone.
 Bullying: To try to harm or intimidate someone.
 Rules: A law or direction that guides behaviour.
 Special: Different from normal or usual.
 Fair: Everyone gets what they need.
 Unfair: People miss out on getting what they need.

Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I can identify similarities and differences between people and appreciate differences.
 Lesson 2: I can explain the difference between unkindness, teasing and bullying and that bullying is rare.
 Lesson 3: I can explain school rules and how they keep us safe.
 Lesson 4: I can identify my special people and why they are special to me.
 Lesson 5: I can recognise and explain what is fair and unfair and kind and unkind.
