Knowledge:

- I know that the wise men visited Jesus after the shepherds.
- I know that Christians believe that Jesus is a gift from God.
- I know that Jesus is God's son and that he is the Messiah.
- I know the Nativity story.

Vocabulary

Gift – something a person gives without wanting anything in return.

Wise men – three kings in the Bible who went to visit baby Jesus to give him gifts.

Magi - according to the New Testament, the three wise men from the East who followed a brilliant star to find the infant Jesus Christ and honour him with gifts.

Jesus – the son of God.

Promise – something that will absolutely happen or be done.

St Nicholas – a Greek bishop and Christian saint known for his giving of small gifts and faithfulness to God.

Lesson 4: I can experience the excitement of giving and be able to explain how it feels.

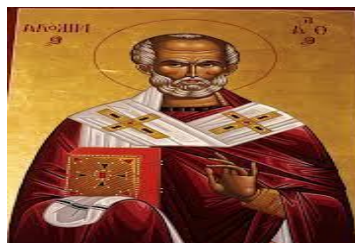
Lesson 5: I have some understanding of being able to give Jesus a gift through my actions and relationships.
