<p>Sculpture is 3D art, usually made by carving, casting, moulding or assembling.</p> <p>Anthony Gormley was born in London, England in 1950.</p> <p>He is a famous sculptor.</p> <p>He made the iron men on Crosby beach.</p> <p>Most of his sculptures are based around the human body and begin with him taking a cast of his own body.</p>	<p>Can learn about form and space through making sculptures.</p> <p>Can use techniques such as pinching and rolling when working with a mouldable material.</p> <p>Can carve into media using tools to create pattern and texture.</p>	<p>Sculptor: An artist who makes sculptures.</p> <p>Clay: A material that can be moulded.</p> <p>3D: Has three dimensions – length, width and height.</p> <p>Carve: Use tools to scrape away parts of a material to create a shape.</p> <p>Mould: To make an object out of a soft material.</p> <p>Assemble: Join different materials/parts together to create an object.</p> <p>Casting: A material is put into a mould while it is liquid and then hardens into a shape.</p>	<p><u>Lesson 1:</u> I know what sculpture is.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2:</u> I know simple facts about Anthony Gormley and his work.</p> <p><u>Lesson 3:</u> I can develop my sculpting skills.</p> <p><u>Lesson 4:</u> I can design my own clay sculpture.</p> <p><u>Lesson 5:</u> I can create my own clay sculpture.</p> <p><u>Lesson 6:</u> Whole class 'art exhibition' to evaluate work.</p>
