Knowledge:

Know the difference between a traditional book and an e-book.
Know how to continue working on a previously saved story.
Know they can save their changes and overwrite the file.

Know how to:

Use the different drawing tools to create a picture on the page.
Add text to a page and change the colour, font and size of the text.

Save their work.

Open work that they saved in the last lesson.

Add an animation to their picture.

Play the pages they have created.

Add a sound to the page.

Add own voice recording to the page.

Create their own music and add it to their page.

Enhance the features of their story book by adding additional pages and animations.

Share their storybook on a class story book display board.

Add a background to the page.

Copy and paste a page in the book.

Vocabulary:

Animation – The process of giving the illusion of movement to drawings and models.

E-Book – A book that can be read on the computer or on a tablet.

Font – The style of text used in a piece of writing on the computer or tablet.

File: A piece of work on the computer.

Sound Effect – A sound other than speech or music made for use in a play, film or computer file.

Display Board – A way to share your work on Purple Mash.

Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I can use drawing tools to create a picture and add text to a page.

Lesson 2: I can add an animation to a page.

Lesson 3: I can add a sound and a voice recording to a page. I can create music for a page.

Lesson 4: I can add a background to a page. I can use the additional drawing tools on My Story mode.

Lesson 5: I can use the copy and paste function to add more pages to my animated e-book.
