#### Knowledge:

- I know the events of Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday are very important
- I know who the characters in the Easter story are
- I know that Christians believe that Jesus died and rose back to life
- I know that Christians believe that Easter is a new beginning

#### Vocabulary

Good Friday - a Christian holiday on the Friday before Easter Sunday that marks the death of Jesus Christ.

Easter Sunday - a Christian holiday to celebrate that Jesus Christ returned to life after he died.

Jesus – the son of God.

new life – new- born animals and humans.

Holy week – the week before Easter Sunday.

Disciples – 12 original followers of Jesus.

Mary – Mother of Jesus.

Resurrections – Return from the dead.

Garden of Gethsemane – the garden where Jesus was arrested before his crucifixion.

Tomb – a grave where someone is buried.

#### Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I can wonder at new life and changes in nature.

Lesson 2: I can reflect upon the miracles of nature and make links between the transformation of animals (butterfly) and the resurrection.

Lesson 3: I can retell the events of Palm Sunday.
