 Year 1 – Spring 2 – Rights and Respect



Knowledge:

Recognise how a person's behaviour (including their own) can affect other people.
 Identify what they like about the school environment.
 Recognise who cares for and looks after the school environment.
 Demonstrate responsibility in looking after something (e.g. a class pet or plant).
 Explain the importance of looking after things that belong to themselves or to others.
 Explain where people get money from.
 List some of the things that money may be spent on in a family home.
 Recognise that different notes and coins have different monetary value.
 Explain the importance of keeping money safe.
 Identify safe places to keep money.
 Understand the concept of 'saving money' (i.e. by keeping it in a safe place and adding to it).
 Basic first aid and what it is.

Vocabulary

Behaviour – How someone acts.
 School environment – Everything that is around us in school.
 Responsibility – Making good choices.
 Money – What we use to buy things.
 Monetary value – How much something is worth.
 Saving money – Looking after and keeping money safe.
 Safe place – A place where money will not get lost or stolen.

Lesson Sequence:

Lesson 1: I can recognise how a person's behaviour (including my own) can affect other people.
 Lesson 2: I can identify what I like about my school environment and I know who looks after it.
 Lesson 3: I know how to look after things, demonstrating respect and responsibility.
 Lesson 4: I know where people get money from and how it is spent at home.
