Vocabulary

Creating Pictures

- Arts and Crafts** – A style of art that often uses nature-inspired patterns.
- Import** – To bring a file, such as an image, into another file or program.
- Palette** – The range of colours or shapes available to use in a computer program.
- De Stijl** – An art style from over 100 years ago that uses straight lines and bright colours.
- Impressionism** – A style of painting that captures light and colour using quick, short brushstrokes.
- Pointillism** – A painting technique that uses tiny dots of colour instead of brushstrokes.
- Digital Portfolio** – A collection of digital files stored together in one place.
- Repeating Pattern** – A decorative design that is shown again and again.
- Fill Tool** – A digital art tool used to fill a shape or area with colour.
- Outline** – A line around a shape or object that helps it stand out.
- Resize** – To change the size of an image or object so it fits a space.
- Image Picker** – A tool or place where images, clipart, or photos can be selected and imported.

Making Music

- Background Music** – Music that plays behind talking or action in a film, TV show, or game.
- Digital Music** – Music that is recorded and stored on a computer or device so it can be played at any time.
- Sound Effect (SFX)** – A sound other than speech or music, used to add interest or realism.
- BPM (Beats Per Minute)** – A measure of how fast or slow a piece of music is played.
- Looping** – Repeating a short section of sound or music over and over again.
- Tune** – The part of the music that you can hum or sing along to.
- Compose** – To create your own piece of music by putting notes and sounds together.
- Volume** – How loud or quiet a sound or note is.
