<p><u>Knowledge:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that: - Henri Matisse was born in France in 1869. He liked to use lots of bold colours. He was a painter, printer, sculptor and made collages. At 72, he couldn't paint due to illness and created collages. Collage is a piece of art made by sticking different materials onto a backing. Texture is how something feels when it is touched. 	<p><u>Vocabulary:</u></p> <p>Henri Matisse - A French artist and sculptor.</p> <p>Collage - a piece of art made from different pieces of paper and materials.</p> <p>Texture - how something feels.</p> <p>Bumpy - covered with lumps or bumps.</p> <p>Fluffy - soft.</p> <p>Fuzzy - not very smooth or clear to feel.</p> <p>Smooth - not rough or fuzzy.</p> <p>Rough - having an uneven surface.</p> <p>Technique - an effective way of doing something.</p> <p>Tearing - ripping.</p> <p>Cutting - using scissors to shape material.</p> <p>Overlapping - putting one piece of material over another.</p> <p>Materials - different things made from lots of different fabrics or other substances.</p>	<p><u>Skills:</u></p> <p>Can cut using scissors to get neat edges.</p> <p>Can stick down firmly using glue or tape.</p> <p>Can use overlapping as a technique for collage.</p> <p>Can use tearing/ripping as a technique for collage</p>	<p><u>Lesson Sequence:</u></p> <p><u>Lesson 1:</u></p> <p>I can understand who Henri Matisse is.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2:</u></p> <p>I can use cutting, tearing and ripping, to explore creating shapes.</p> <p><u>Lesson 3:</u></p> <p>I can design artwork in the style of Henri Matisse.</p> <p><u>Lesson 4:</u></p> <p>I can create my own piece of artwork in the style of Matisse .</p> <p><u>Lesson 5:</u></p> <p>I can evaluate my work and my peer's work.</p>
