Vocabulary

Bible - the Christian Holy book.

Old Testament - the first part of the Holy bible, which has 39 books.

New Testament - the second part of the Holy Bible and records the life of Christ and his earliest followers. It has 27 books.

Gospel - the good news that God the father has sent his son, Jesus Christ, to forgive sins.

Mary Jones - a famous lady who walked 26 miles barefoot to get her own Bible.

Dead Sea Scrolls - the remains of about 800-900 ancient manuscripts.

Qu'ran - the Muslim holy book.

Torah - the Jewish holy book.

Guru Granth Sahib - Sikh holy book.
