Key vocabulary

Land use	Land use is simply what people use land for, like building houses (residential), growing food (agriculture), making things in factories (industrial), or having parks (commercial).
Agriculture	Agriculture is farming and growing plants, raising animals and helping people get the things they need like materials from animals.
Farming	The job of growing plants, and raising animals to provide people with food, clothing, materials and other useful things.
Arable	Arable means land that's good for growing crops on because the soil is suitable for planting seeds and plowing.
Livestock	Farm animals raised for a profit (money), which provide things like milk, eggs, wool and sometimes work.
Residential	A place where people live.
Commercial	Somewhere that places sell things for money or make money.
Industrial	Places with big factories making lots of things, not just farms and small shops.
Woodland	A place with lots of trees but not as packed as a forest so sunlight can reach the ground helping small plants and grass to grow.
Biodiversity	This means all the different kinds of life on Earth like plants, animals, bugs, germs, humans and how they all work together to make our planet the best!

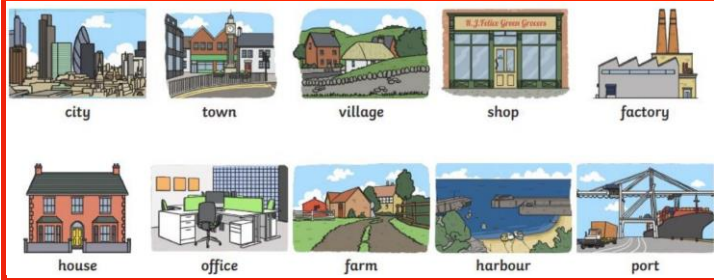
